1. Christian-Based Alternative

The Foundry House is a Christian-based alternative for recovery houses, which can otherwise cost several thousands per month. The prospective guest does not have to be a Christian to apply but will be expected to complete all program curriculum, which includes Bible study as well as attending church services and Celebrate Recovery.

The program is 8 months in length and employment is the expectation no later than 60 days from the start of the program. You must be able-bodied and willing to work as a part of your recovery and restoration. This part of the program is mandatory and cannot be waived.

Financial Sponsorship of \$750 for the potential guest to have all room and board taken care of for the first 45 days to focus solely on his own recovery.

Recovery Deposit of a minimum of \$250 by the guest himself to invest in his own recovery. This cannot be provided by sponsorship or scholarship. The Recovery Deposit is the potential guest being willing to “bet on himself” and the amount in its entirety will be returned to him as a graduation gift after completing the program in 8 months.

Program Fees will be paid by the guest out of his paycheck upon employment. These program fees will average out to \$150/week over the course of his 8-month stay at The Foundry House.
